- Embracing new faith formation leadership roles

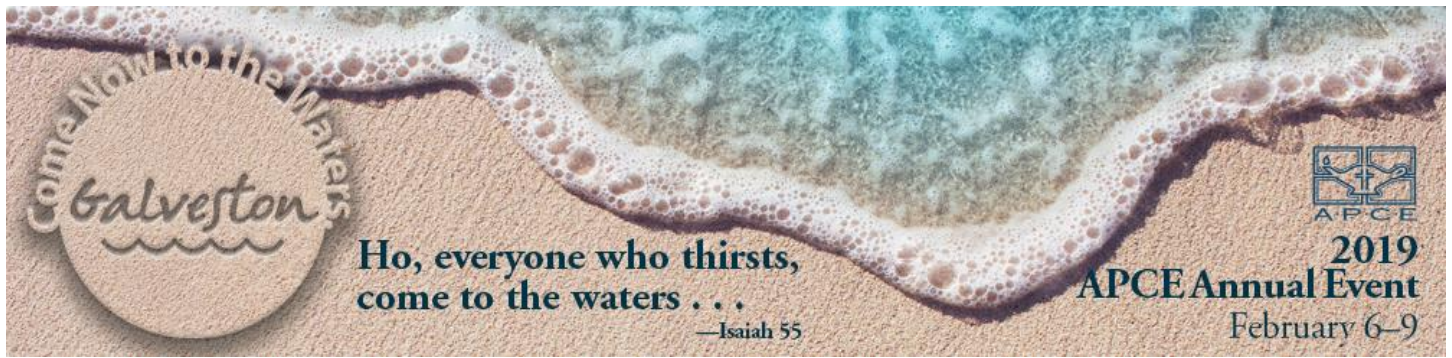

Experience silence at Villa de Matel's Ruah Spirituality Center. Ruah is located within Villa de Matel, the motherhouse of The Congregation of the Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word (CCVI), less than an hour from Galveston. Ruah's spaces are set apart for silence. Silence is presented as nonnegotiable: it is offered as a gift and guarded as a treasure for those who seek. Here people are led to rest in God's presence; then the same Breath of God (ruah) who drew them here sends them out to confidently echo the good news of God's love on the streets of their lives. There are numerous prayer spaces within the center, a labyrinth on the grounds and trails for walking. Participants will be oriented to the space and then will spend about 4 hours in silence, ending with a time of debriefing the experience led by a spiritual director.
