1. "Journey to Bethlehem" Advent Series:

FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT - JOURNEY WITH MARY
Prayer Practice – Through the Eyes of Mary
SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT - JOURNEY WITH JOSEPH
Prayer Practice – Joseph as Carpenter, Husband, Father
THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT - JOURNEY WITH THE INNKEEPER
Prayer Practice – Crowded & Los Pasados
FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT - JOURNEY WITH THE SHEPHERD
Prayer Practice – "Light of the World"
EPIPHANY - JOURNEY WITH THE MAGI
Prayer Practice – "Quest of the Magi" Meditation

2. "Come to the Table" Lenten Series

Table of Mercy - At Table with Sinners – Calling Levi
Party Table; Prayer Practice= Burning/washing away sins
Table of Forgiveness - Jesus Anointed at Simon's Table
Table in Bible time Home; Prayer Practice=Anointing
Table of Grace - At Mary & Martha's Table
Kitchen Table; Prayer Practice= Sitting with Jesus reflection
Table of Blessing - At the Banquet Table - "A Hungry Table"
Table set for a King; Prayer Practice=Plate of Excuses
Table of Hospitality - At Table with Pharisees
Pharisees' Table; Prayer Practice=Paper Prayers/Prayer Wall
Palm Sunday – Trouble at the Table – Turning Tables in Temple
Table on its side with coins etc. spilled on the floor
Maundy Thursday – "The Last Supper" Table in the Upper Room
Table by the Sea - 1st Sunday after Easter - Eating with the Resurrected Jesus
Picnic Table – picnic spread out on the floor

3. "Living Water" Lenten Series:

Glass Jars and a blue bag with symbols and instructions handed out Ash Wednesday & First Sunday in Lent. New symbol each week. Reader brings in a large symbol and places it on the Lord's Table and lights the Christ Candle. Candle is in a bowl of water with glass symbols added each week.

Ash Wednesday - CLEANSING Waters – "Clean Hearts"
Experience - Stones out of the water in the font as enter, glass heart bead out of the water as leave; Symbol – glass jar taken home to fill with water & add Heart glass gem
1st Sunday in Lent - REFRESHING Waters - "Water in the Wilderness"
Jordan River & Wilderness Temptation
Table = Stones/Burlap/Sand; Exp. – Sprinkled Waters; Symbol = sand (scarcity of water in the wilderness)

2nd Sunday in Lent - MIRACULOUS Waters - "Water into Wine"

Wedding in Cana & Anointing

Table = Glass Pitcher & Cup (red tablet in glass cup); Exp.= Anointing with Oil;

Symbol = Red glass gem (Miracle)

3rd Sunday in Lent - HEALING Waters - "Washed By the Water"

Healing at the Pool, Man with Leprosy

Table = Blue fabric waters out of Pitcher; Exp.= Healing Waters; Symbol = Blue glass gem (water)

4th Sunday in Lent - CALMING Waters – "Waters of Galilee"

Jesus Calms the Storm, Walks on Water

Table = White/glittery waves added with ribbons; Exp. = Meditation – Imaginative Prayer of getting out of boat; Symbol= Wavy Glass bead (waves)

5th Sunday in Lent - RENEWING Waters – "Well of Living Water"

Woman at the Well

Table = Clay pitcher added with fabric water pouring out; Exp. = Cup of cold water;

Symbol = Square glass tile (Wet Stepping Stones)

Palm Sunday RESTORING Waters – "Washed Clean"

Final Week in Jerusalem, Washing the Disciples feet

Symbol = Blue Marble

Easter Symbol = Glass Butterfly

Notes: Congregational Response – "What Can Wash Away My Sin?" verse 1

Reader shares the "I Thirst Statements" followed by the congregation's response "I thirst". Adapted each week to fit the theme.

FIRST SUNDAY IN LENT The Feast of Tabernacles/Booths

Booth setup over the Lord's Table/ 3rd Fall Feast – Sukkot (Booths) / Prayer Practice = water

SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT The Day of Atonement/Yom Kippur

2nd Fall Feast = Scapegoat, incense / Prayer Practice = sins given away

THIRD SUNDAY IN LENT The Feast of Trumpets (Jewish New Year = Shofar)

First of the Fall Feasts/Rosh Hashanah / Prayer Practice = stones w/ sins written on in water

FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT The Feast of Pentecost/Weeks (Shavuot=One Body)

4th Spring Feast Prayer Practice = signs and wonders

FIFTH SUNDAY IN LENT The Feast of Firstfruits

3rd Spring Feast = firstfruits/harvest/gleaning/marketing/gathering/presenting

Prayer Practice = Thanksgiving Prayer

PALM SUNDAY- Entering the Week of Passover-Passover Feast

First of the Spring Feasts Waving of Palms & Palm Crosses

MAUNDY THURSDAY – The Feast of Unleavened Bread

5. CANOEING THE MOUNTAINS: Adapting in Uncharted Territory

Based on lessons from Tod Bolsinger's book "Canoeing the Mountains: Christian Leadership in Uncharted Territory"

Week 1 - "The Adventure with Lewis & Clark" - Intro. to "Canoeing the Mountains"

"Lewis & Clark were experienced river rafters who had to learn to be mountaineers"

Exodus 14:31, Psalm 31: 1-8, 14-16 - This is an opportunity for adventure, exploration and transformation. This is a moment when we as a congregation can take on new life, begin a new season of ministry and start imaging different possibilities.

Adventure, trust, courage/ "Monuments or Footprints?" = Exercise

Week 2 - "The Landscape, The Challenge, The Adventure"

"We are experienced river rafters who must learn to be mountaineers" 1 Corinthians 12:12-27

Working together as the Body of Christ/Reorientation/Navigational Guide

What losses/adjustments do we anticipate? = Letting Go Exercise

Week 3 - "Unchartered Territory"

"We are not adapting to merely survive but to thrive!" Psalm 121

The World in Front is Nothing Like the World Behind/ Transforming

Brainstorming = Exercise

Week 4 - "Off the Map" Psalm 9:7-10, John 20:19-22

"It is possible to prepare for the future without knowing what it will be."

Trusting when we are off the map/ Preparing for the Unknown

If you are embarking on a potentially dangerous journey, what would you want in the trip leader and what do you take with you?

Week 5 - "Navigating New Geography" Proverbs 3:1-6, Joel 2:28

"We are not going to rely on our canoes when we are facing mountains"

Adapting in Uncharted Territory/ I have a Dream (pg 142)/ The Mission Always Wins

Visioning our Future Ministry (narrowing down the brainstorming = Exercise
