

Director of Children and Youth Ministries / Youth Director, Logan Utah

Job Description: This is a joint position with First Presbyterian Church of Logan and the Presbytery of Utah. We have combined these into one position, which provides for more significant compensation and benefits for the candidate.

For First Presbyterian Church of Logan, this position requires enthusiasm and love for working with young people in a ministry setting, along with solid interpersonal skills. You should be able to work a flexible 25-hour week including occasional evening and weekend activities, and hours on Sunday.

Duties include: Coordinate activities of the church into an integrated and effective ministry for Christian Education. Provide leadership for and develop our Children & Family Ministry program. We have moved from a traditional Sunday School program to a once-a-month Sunday afternoon activity for children and families. Provide leadership for and develop our Middle & High School youth ministry program (currently a combined twice-monthly Monday evening gathering). Provide for ministry opportunities among Young Adults/College persons. Serve as a guide and consultant to the Christian Education Committee. Resource, coordinate, and train volunteer staff regarding youth ministry or Christian education activities.

For the Presbytery of Utah, the Youth Director will plan, coordinate, advertise, and recruit four (4) quarterly youth events in a calendar year.

Duties include: The events will be planned for youth attending Presbyterian Church (USA) congregations and their friends. These will typically be weekend-long events, and will include elements of service, fellowship, and corporate worship. Each event is to be hosted by a different congregation in the Presbytery, in order that our youth might experience different PC(USA) worship styles and landscapes throughout Utah. All promotional materials will be developed by, produced by, and distributed by the Director, with the assistance of the Presbytery. Fundraise for the quarterly events, coordinating with office staff to ensure that funds are safeguarded, appropriately accounted for, and available for disbursement, including financial aid for families who request it. Design the process for determining the appropriate disbursement of financial aid. This work is expected to take 10 hours per week on average.

Both the First Presbyterian Church of Logan and the Presbytery of Utah are open and affirming of the LGBTQIA+ community and expect the staff to extend that same affirmation to their youth, churches, and community. A more detailed list of responsibilities for both of the positions, as well as evaluation processes are available upon application.

Compensation: \$47,000 annually, with additional funds for health coverage (through PCUSA Board of Pensions if you desire), and professional expense/continuing education funds.
