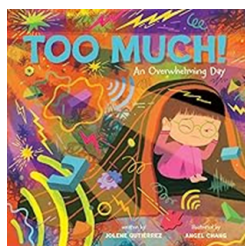

The Book of Belonging: Bible Stories for Kind and Contemplative Kids

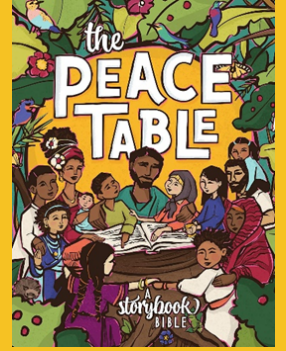
by Mariko Clark and Rachel Eleanor
