to get access to the free resources

### STEP 1

Tell the church leader you'd like to be added to the platform. They'll submit the grown-up(s) first and last name(s) and email address(es).

### STEP 2

Brittany, the project director at GenOn, will create an account for you. That will give you free access to all of the resources.



### STEP 3

You'll start getting weekly emails from Brittany with suggestions for you and your family to try out that week.

### STEP 4

You'll receive a few emails from "GenOn Christian Parenting Project." Start with the email "Your New GenOn Christian Parenting Project Account". This email will allow you to set up your password.

### STEP 5

Take some time to explore the platform. You can watch Brittany's welcome video to get a great overview of what to expect. Scan the QR code to access the video.

### STEP 6

After setting up your password, you'll gain access to all of your "offers." The remaining emails say what those offers are—Families, Parents and Caregivers, and Parenting and Spiritual Formation.
