



#### Rebuilding, Growing


Want kids in worship to learn bout worship, be part of larger community

Hard to teach multiple ages together, but don't have enough to split


Youth is mostly middle school, very few high schoolers




# WHAT ARE OUR CHALLENGES?

Finding appropriate, engaging curriculum 6%



#### STRUGGLES

• It's not a priority for families.

 People won't come to anything outside of Sunday morning.

> Our kids go to different school/school systems with different schedules. Make it hard to plan.

> > • I have to plan something in case people show up, but often they don't.

#### JOYS

• Sunday School regained strength after the pandemic.

• The old model is still working. If it ain't broke, why "fix" it?

 We dropped Sunday School on Sunday morning, but have found that LOGOS/Intergenerational on Wednesday evenings is working well.

• It's slow, but we are growing!


