



- for all teachers, bus drivers, custodians, administrators, nutrition specialists, counselors, psychologists, nurses, and volunteers who give all that they have, knowing that more is needed.

Always Nonpartisan--


- Churches and Nonprofits CANNOT and SHOULD NOT be Partisan. We can advocate for POSITIONS but NOT candidates or political parties.
- We can encourage you TO vote. We cannot tell you HOW to vote.
- If we must be partisan, we are partisan on the side of the poor and vulnerable only!
