## **Presbyterian Pan American School – School Chaplain (Full-Time, Residential Position)**

Presbyterian Pan American School (PPAS), located in Kingsville, Texas, is a Christian, international, college-preparatory boarding high school serving students from across the Americas and beyond. Rooted in faith, academic excellence, and leadership, PPAS provides a nurturing, multicultural community where students are prepared for success in university and a life of service guided by Christian values.

PPAS is seeking a bilingual (English/Spanish) ordained minister to serve as School Chaplain. The Chaplain will lead the spiritual life of the school, including chapel services, prayer gatherings, and faith-based programming, while providing pastoral care and guidance to students, faculty, and staff. This is a residential position, requiring the Chaplain to live on campus and play an active role in student and residential life, including mentoring students, supporting weekend activities, and collaborating closely with the residential and student life teams.

The ideal candidate will hold a Master of Divinity (M.Div.), be an ordained minister (Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) preferred) and demonstrate a strong commitment to working with adolescents in a diverse, international environment. Candidates must be fully bilingual in English and Spanish, possess strong interpersonal and pastoral care skills, and be willing to engage fully in the life of a boarding school community. A valid driver's license is required; experience in youth ministry or boarding school settings is preferred.

The ability to contribute to the academic and spiritual formation of students through Bible or Christian Life instruction is highly valued, though not required.

Compensation and benefits for this position will be structured in accordance with applicable Terms of Call for ministers, which include total "effective salary" (cash salary and housing), along with benefits such as medical coverage, retirement savings plan, and other elements as defined by the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) Board of Pensions. Housing is provided on campus and will be included as part of the overall compensation structure.
